

Included are The Wildlife Center's activities directed toward contract requirements for the Share with Wildlife grant. Tasks were organized and delivered by The Wildlife Center's (TWC) Education Director, Tracy Carroll.

*Organized and delivered a four-session training to train new educator/handlers on curricula which covers conservation oriented topics around TWC's raptors, including several raptors which are species of concern. We are emphasizing native birds of prey and their habitat requirements, habitat conservation and human/wildlife conflicts and how humans are impacting wild animal populations. The Wildlife Center has added 12 new educator/handlers to help us in delivering our programs. These volunteers are actively participating in our programs.

*Created and distributed fliers to local public schools advertising free programs sponsored by New Mexico Game and Fish's Share with Wildlife grant.

*Trained one of our burrowing owls, listed as a species of concern, to be jessed and to stand on a gloved hand during program presentation. This bird is now being used for program presentations. During the program we educate students on how humans are affecting burrowing owl habitats and how loss of populations is affecting ecosystems as a whole. The close association of Burrowing Owls and Prairie Dogs allows us to address Prairie Dog habitat concerns and the current status of the Gunnison's Prairie Dog.

The Education Committee met throughout the year to address curriculum design and materials that will create an enhanced educational experience. We are beginning to better differentiate program levels, building a curriculum that advances students through grade levels. We met with teachers in Espanola and in Los Alamos to discuss the potential for extended lesson plans for teachers and pre and post materials for programs conducted at The Wildlife Center. We expect that within 3 years The Wildlife Center will have grade appropriate conservation education that incorporates the science standards and includes 3 lesson plans and activities for classroom teachers.

Following is a list of programs provided to satisfy the contract requirements for the Share With Wildlife grant. The Wildlife Center did not collect any fees for these programs. Rather, The Wildlife Center will be reimbursed the indicated amounts for each program.
