SUMMARY: In 2008, between February 14 and June 30, the handlers and volunteers at the Raptor Center presented a total of 39 programs, reaching 2000 children and 1730 adults in varied venues. Programs involved the non-releasable raptors under the care of the Santa Fe Raptor Center. These include a Flammulated Owl (FLOW), Western Screech Owl (SCOW), Burrowing Owl (BUOW), Merlin Falcon (MEFA), Red-tailed Hawk (RTHA), and Peregrine Falcon (PEFA). An overview of an entire year's programs is found in the attached 2007 Annual Report of the Raptor Center.
