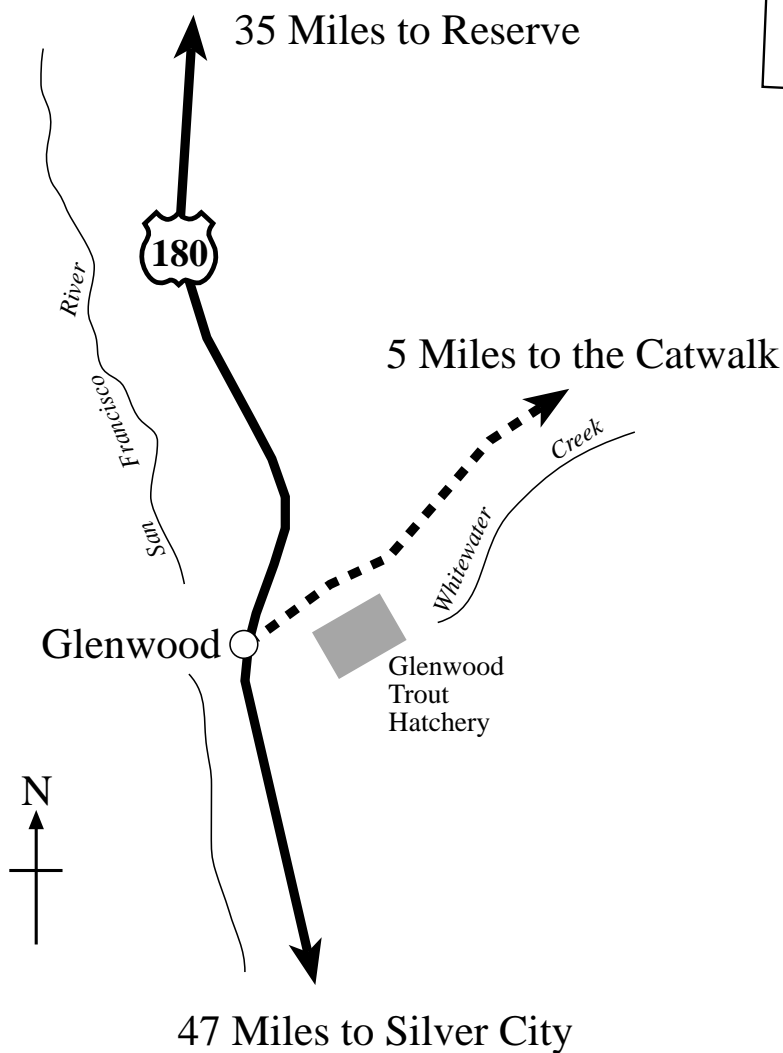
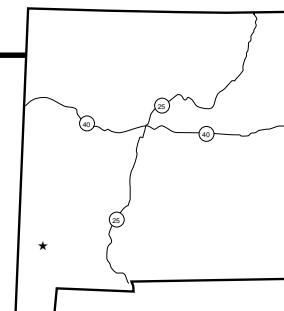




State Wildlife Areas

Glenwood State Hatchery



Glenwood Trout Hatchery, located at Glenwood Village in Catron County, was built in 1938. The hatchery boasts an average annual production of 53,000 pounds of rainbows, more than 400,000 trout.

Most of the fish go to waters in the southwestern quadrant of the state— including a pond on the hatchery grounds. The pond and the picnicking facilities at the hatchery include paved access trails and a fishing ramp for wheelchairs.
