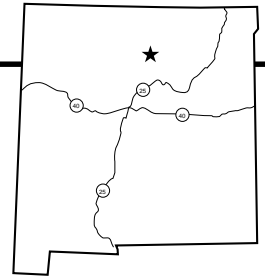
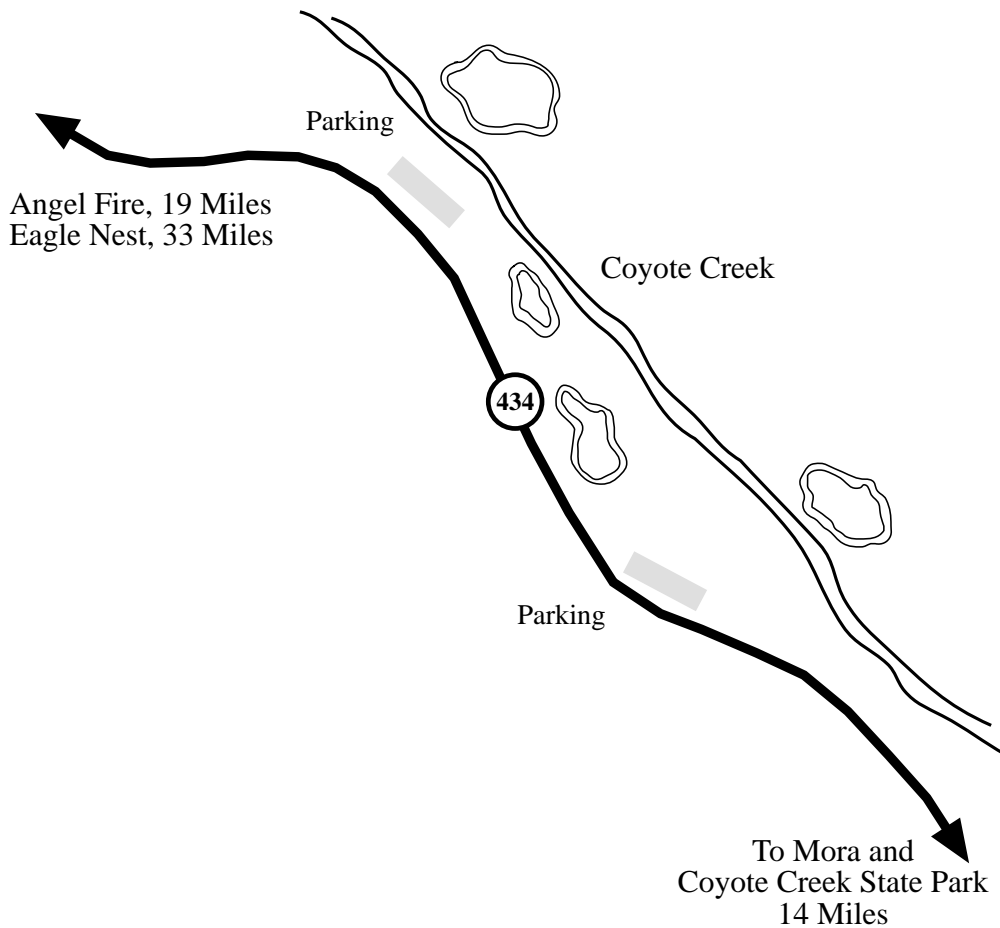




State Wildlife Areas



Harold S. Brock Fishing Easement



Forested mountain ridges surround Coyote Creek, where the Harold L. Brock Fishing Area is found north of Coyote Creek State Park. Over a mile of stream access offers public fishing for rainbow and brown trout.

Camping is available at the nearby state park.

Harold L. Brock Fishing Area is located between Mora and Eagle Nest on a good road that winds through Guadalupita Canyon. The Rincon Mountains lie to the west.
