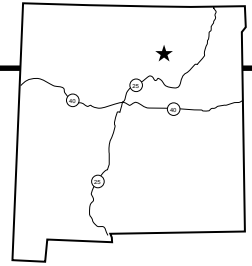
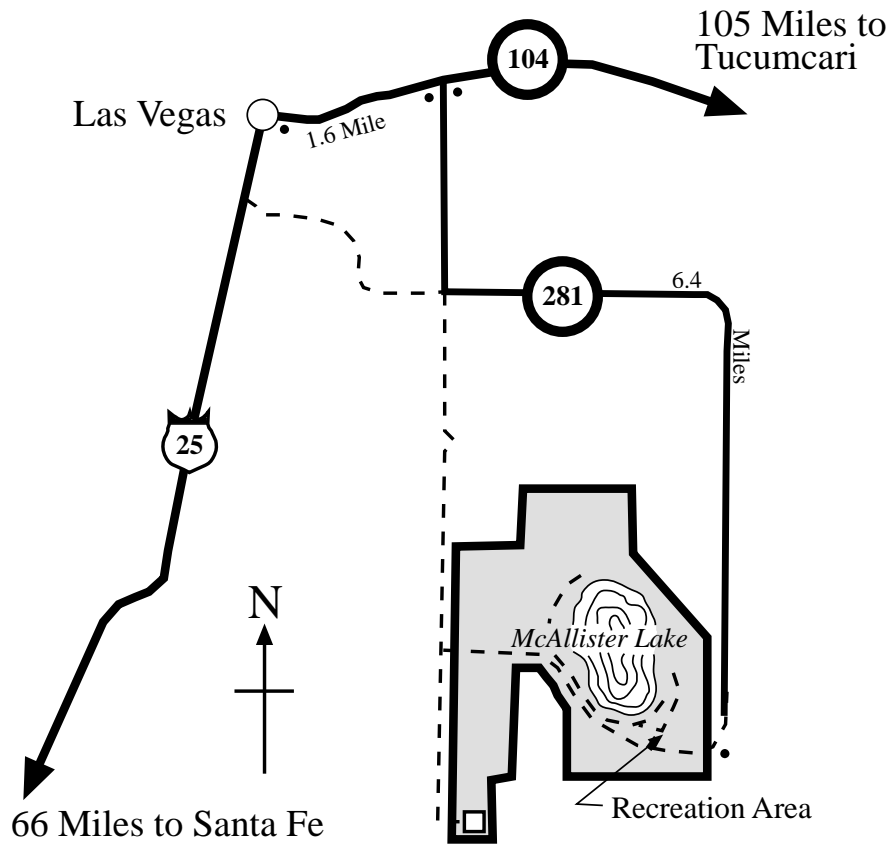




State Wildlife Areas



McAllister Lake Fishing/Waterfowl Area



Wavelets plopping and splashing on a lake bank at night seem louder, perhaps more important, than they do during the brighter hours. To a night fisherman, they may be sole company to the tension growing within him as his line goes beyond his bobbing light and into dark water.

The wait, at McAllister Lake Fishing and Waterfowl Area, may be rewarded with the strike and deep run of a lunker rainbow.

Surrounded by farm and grazing lands, with the Sangre de Cristo Mountains looming to the west, McAllister provides pleasure for the fisherman and those interested in studying the habits of waterfowl and eagles that winter here.

Camping and boat launching facilities are located at the south and west ends. Recreational sites for picnickers are also available on McAllister's south side.

Fishing is allowed from March 1 through Oct. 31.
