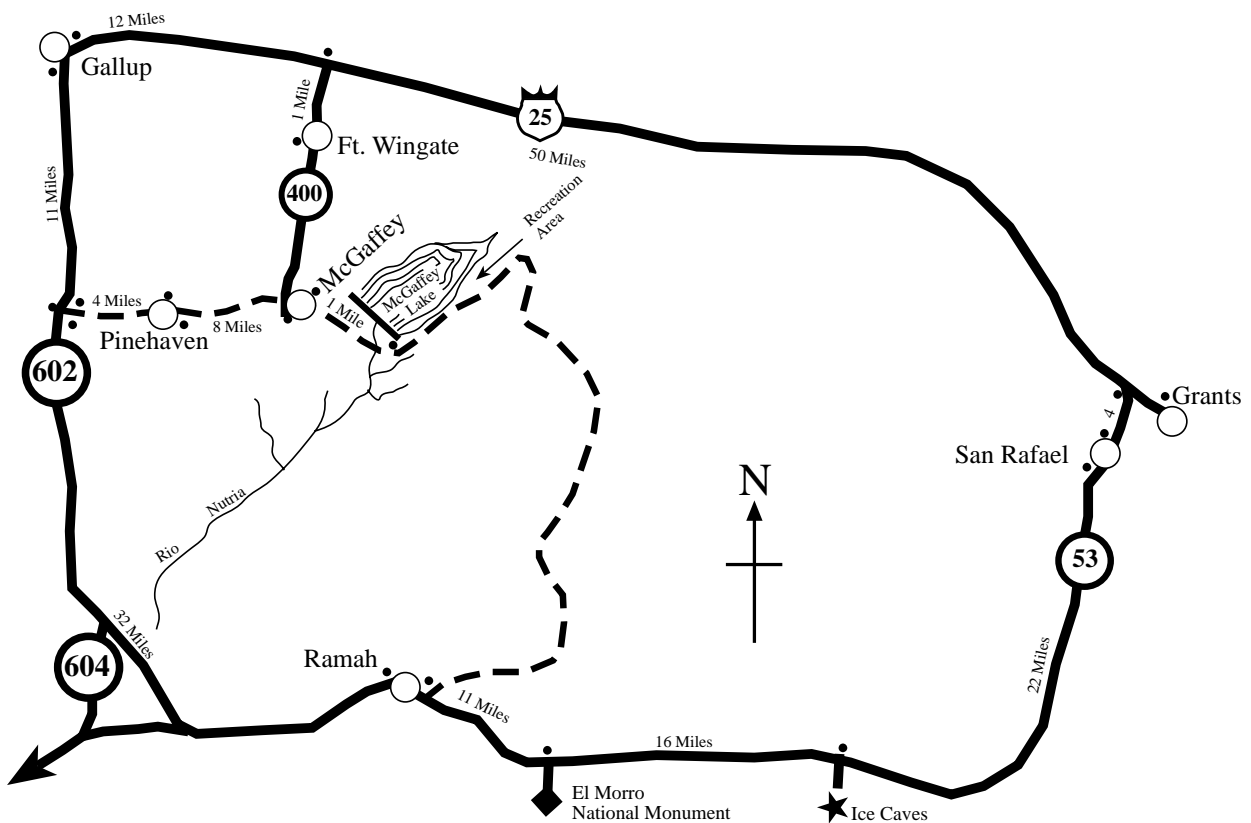
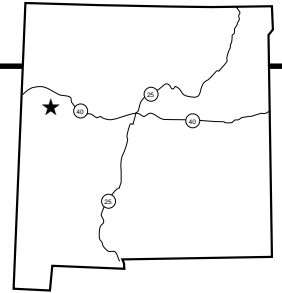




# State Wildlife Areas

## McGaffey Lake



Few areas surpass McGaffey Lake for scenery, situated as it is in an open forest of ponderosas limned by gaudy, impossible sunsets that sweep across this country each summer evening.

At an elevation of 7,600 feet, the lake is stocked with rainbow trout. Fishing is regularly good, and nearby scenic and historic sites add to this lake's attractions.

The Department of Game and Fish obtained permission to make dam and spillway improvements and to maintain and operate the lake thus impounded through an easement with the McKinley County Game Protective Association in 1953 and a special use permit from the U.S. Forest Service in 1954.
