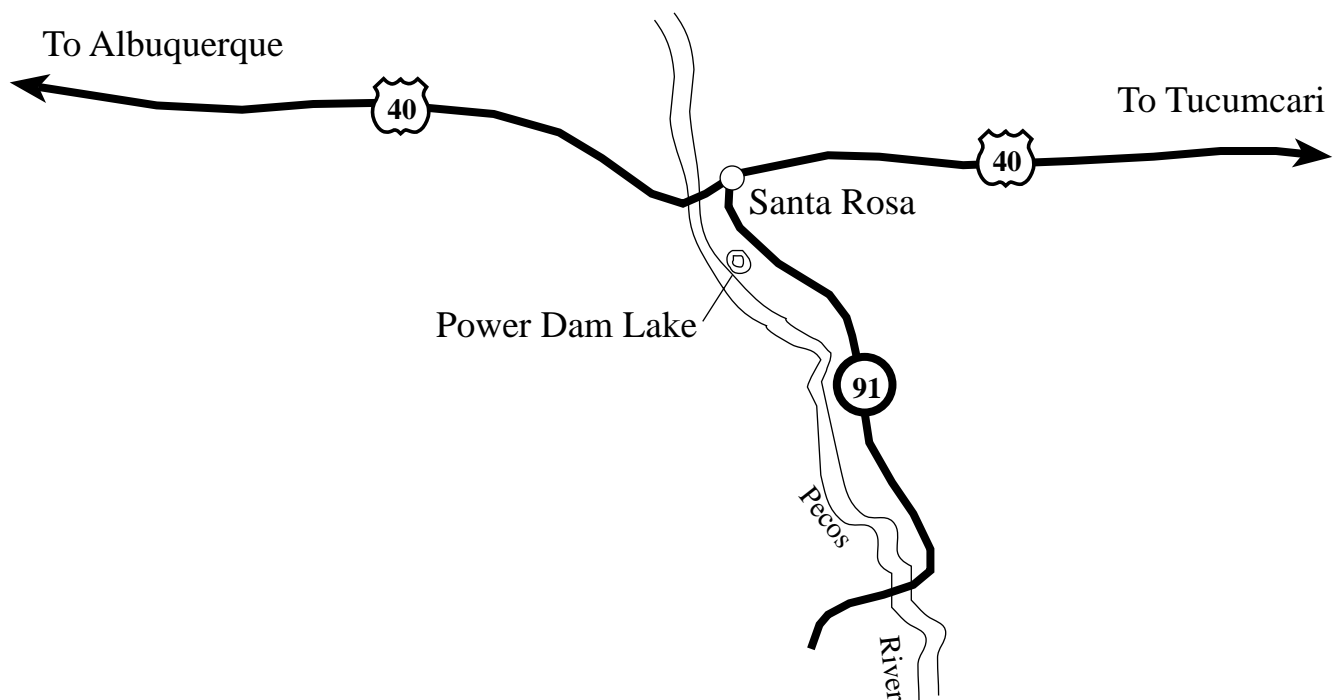
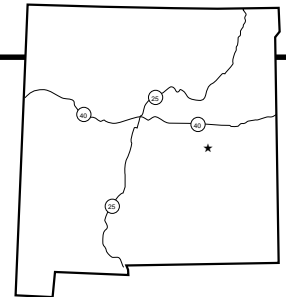




State Wildlife Areas

Power Dam Lake



Power Dam Lake was leased by the State Game Commission in March 1965 from the city of Santa Rosa. The 13-acre lake is a mile south of the city and offers convenient access to anglers.

Main species include bluegill sunfish, channel catfish and rainbow trout. In the past, bullheads, crappie and sucker have been reported in the lake. The outlet drains down the Rito de Agua Negra Chiquita, and then to the Pecos River.

Outdoor toilets, picnic tables, trees and a gravel access road are available.

The water level is maintained at 38 acre feet.
