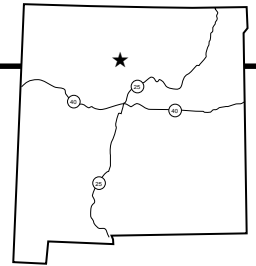

Seven Springs Hatchery



Squat silos, white-sided and stepped in a row down the northern slope of Cebolla Creek canyon, distinguish the Seven Springs Hatchery from those of the traditional ponds and raceways— although it has these, too.

The silos—3,500-gallon barrels— were part of a research project that has brought smiles of success to fisheries biologists’ faces. The silos — vertical raceways, officially — maintain and produce large numbers of fish with a reduction in manpower.

You can take advantage of angling opportunities at nearby Fenton Lake for some of the trout produced at Seven Springs.

No camping facilities are provided at the hatchery, but Calaveras campground and picnic area is nearby, and more facilities are located at Fenton Lake.
