

MANDATORY HARVEST REPORTING REQUIREMENT INFORMATION

Who must report?

- Any person that holds a public draw deer permit
- Any person that holds a private land only deer permit
- Any person that holds a private land elk license
- Any person that holds a public draw elk license
- Any person that hunted on a public deer or elk population reduction hunt
- Any person that hunted on a private deer or elk population reduction hunt
- Any person that holds a trapper license
- All deer and elk hunters and trapper license holders must report even if they did not go hunting or trapping

How can you report your harvest?

What is the deadline to report your harvest?

- For **DEER** and **ELK** hunters, the deadline is February 15, 2008 (or prior to the application deadline for population reduction hunts, bear WMA, oryx and turkey if you are applying for these hunts)
- For **TRAPPERS**, the deadline is March 31, 2008 (note: do not file a trapping report until you are finished for the season)

What will happen if you fail to report your harvest?

- All applications submitted for any public draw hunts (including the conversion of landowner authorizations) will be rejected.

What dates should you remember for the 2008-09 special hunts drawings?

- February 6, 2008- Application deadline for population reduction hunts, bear WMA, oryx and turkey draw hunts. You **MUST** submit your 2007-08 **DEER and/or ELK** harvest report before submitting an application (note: trapping reports do not have to be submitted by this date if applying for these hunts)
- February 15, 2008 - Deadline for all elk and deer hunters to file their harvest report and not be faced with a late fee.
- April 9, 2008- Application deadline for public deer permits, Units 4 and 5A private land deer permits, elk, pronghorn antelope, ibex, javelina, and bighorn sheep. You **MUST** submit your 2007-08 **DEER, ELK and/or TRAPPER** harvest report before submitting an application

What will happen if you miss the February 15 deadline to report your harvest?

- You may submit your harvest report late but will be charged an \$8.00 late fee.

- You still must submit your harvest report before the special hunts application deadlines or your application will be rejected.
