

Obtaining an OHV Permit

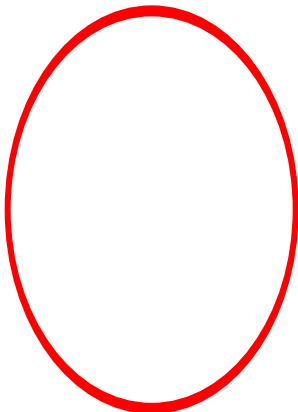
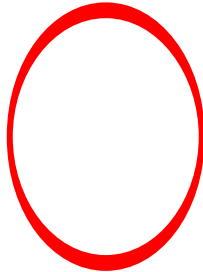
Registration is required for OHVs prior to using them on any public lands in New Mexico. Vehicles that are considered OHVs include:

- All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV)
- Dirt Bikes
- Off-Road Vehicles (ORV, UTV, or mule-type Vehicles)
- Snowmobiles

New Mexico Residents are required to register their OHV at any Motor Vehicle Division Field Office.

- This online Off-Highway vehicle permit purchasing system is intended for use by those who do not reside in New Mexico. New Mexico residents must register their vehicles with the Motor Vehicle Department.
- The Off-Highway Vehicle permit requirement and associated rules apply to riders on public lands in New Mexico.
- All items with the bear icon " " will have a permit number that can be printed and temporarily used as a permit while the stick-on permit is being mailed.
- Riders under the age of 18 must have helmets, protective eyewear, and have proof they have taken a safety training course.
- Riders younger than 10 must ride age-appropriate vehicles and be visually supervised by a parent or legal guardian at all times. Other riders under 18 must be visually supervised by a parent, legal guardian, or person older than 18 with a valid driver's license unless the under-age rider has a valid motorcycle or instructional permit, or a valid driver's license.
- The New Mexico Department of Game and Fish recommends that OHV permit purchasers read the appropriate rules on www.B4uride.com for more information before making any purchase.
- Add a \$4.95 Internet / Vendor Fee to the total amount for all permits.
