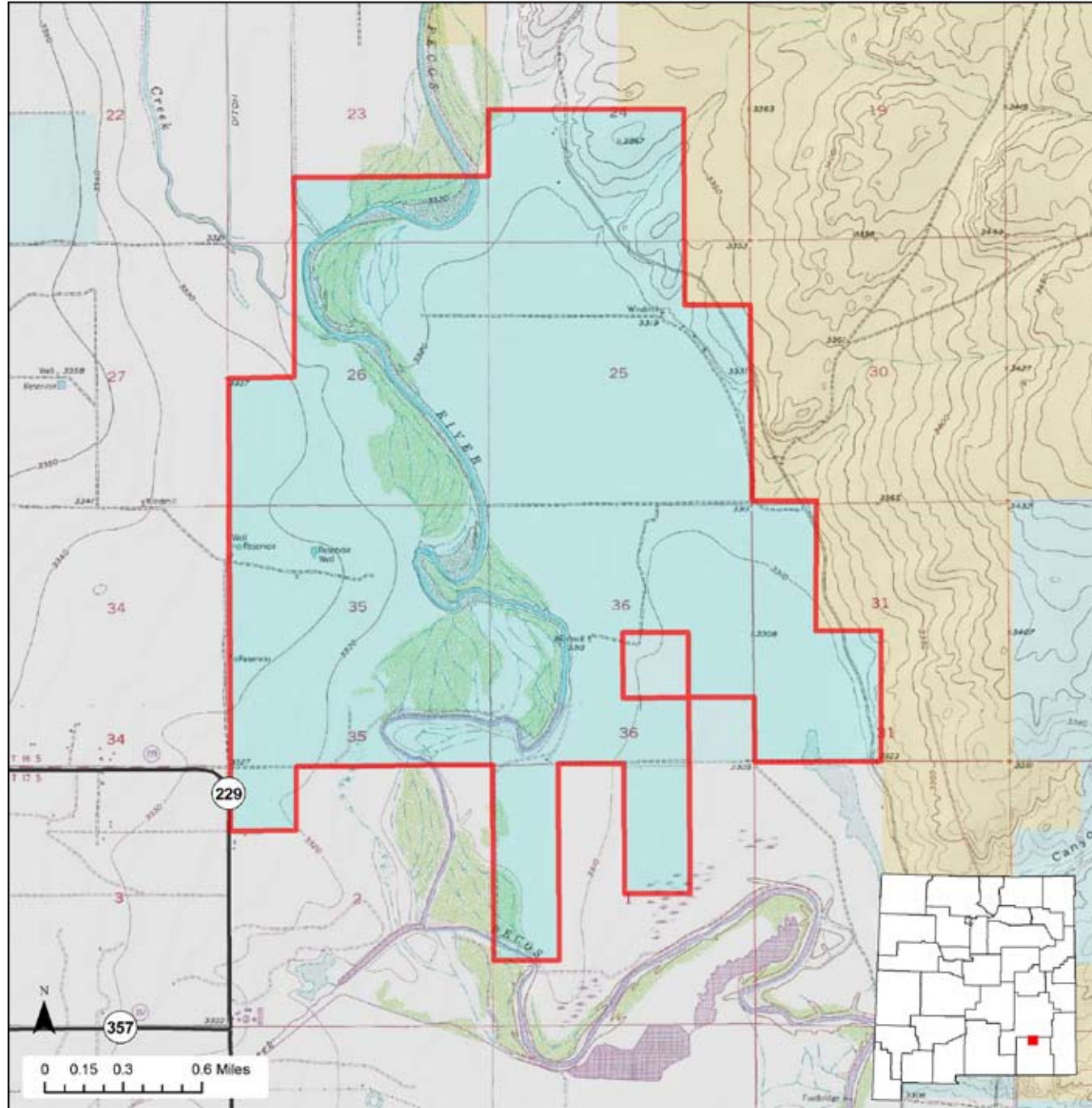




William S. Huey Wildlife Area



Location: The William S. Huey Wildlife Area is located on the Pecos River between Artesia and Carlsbad.

Total Acreage: 2,880 acres.

Purchase: William S. Huey Wildlife Area was dedicated in 1986 to mitigate habitat loss caused by Brantley Dam.

Description: The William S. Huey Wildlife Area covers land on both sides of the Pecos River in southern New Mexico. This area contains flat farm land, grazing land and a river bosque.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Wildlife Viewing ✓ Photographing 	<p>Wildlife Viewing-Wildlife watchers may see deer and turkey, various songbirds, quail, and waterfowl year-round. Good binoculars are important. The best time to view wildlife is at dawn or dusk.</p>
<p>Access</p>	<p>Photographing-The best time to photograph wildlife is at dawn or dusk. A telephoto lens may be important.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Hiking 	<p>Hiking-Hiking is the best way to see wildlife year-round at the William S. Huey Wildlife Area or other wildlife management areas.</p>
<p>Hunting and Fishing</p>	<p>Bicycling-Not allowed.</p> <p>Horseback Riding-Not allowed.</p> <p>Camping-Not allowed.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Hunting ✓ Fishing 	<p>Fishing-Allowed year-round.</p> <p>Hunting-Small game hunting and limited draw deer, draw turkey, and draw pheasant hunts.</p>
<p>Closures</p>	<p>Closures-Activities allowed only in designated areas. See specific restrictions posted at the William S. Huey Wildlife Area.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ No 	<p>Facilities-William S. Huey Wildlife Area does not have rest rooms, camp sites, or drinking water.</p>
<p>Facilities</p>	<p>Fees-Hunters and anglers must have appropriate licenses and permits. Wildlife viewers, photographers, and hikers must have a valid license or permit. See the Department's website www.wildlife.state.nm.us for more information.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ No rest rooms ✓ No camp sites ✓ No drinking water 	<p>Fees-Hunters and anglers must have appropriate licenses and permits.
