- Pintail bag limit to remain at one
- Adjust sandhill crane permits based on increased allocation
- Virtual public meeting will be held March 10

Sandhill Crane Permits

- Greater sandhill crane harvest allotment increased for 2022-23 based on population surveys and crane management plan
- 2021-22 allocation: 831, 2022-23 allocation: 988
- Proposed changes to permit numbers:

Estancia Valley—stay the same

MRGV—add permits

Southwest—stay the same
