Repeal and Replace: Revocation 19.31.2 NMAC

- ☐ Establish clear time frames for revocations
- □ Allow department to recommend enhanced or reduced revocations based on individual cases and points accrued
- ☐ Change point categories to 40, 20, 10, 5 and 3
- □ Streamline administrative process

Enhancement

Enhancement: The Department may recommend any period of revocation longer than those set to a hearing officer if a hearing is requested or to the GC if no hearing is requested, when:

- Violator has accrued 40 or more violation pts
- Violator is subject to civil restitution for a trophy animal, or
- If violator accrues more points while revoked.
- Any recommendation shall be supported with written justification detailing the egregious circumstances
- Neither the hearing officer nor the commission shall be bound by the department's recommendation

Mitigation

Mitigation: The Department may recommend any period of revocation shorter than those set to a hearing officer or the GC if no hearing is requested;

- When the Department believes mitigating circumstances exist
- Recommendation shall be in writing detailing the mitigating circumstances
- Neither the hearing officer nor GC is bound by the Departments recommendation

Criminal Revocation Categories & Points

- Create a 40 pt. category to aid in defining egregious violations
- Simplify points by having 40, 20, 10, 5 and 3 point categories
- Point designations were set based on severity of criminal violations

Egregious Violations

40 pt. Criminal Violations:

- Spotlighting
- Felony waste of game
- Sale / purchase of game animals or parts
- Shooting from an aircraft
- Applying/receiving OG registration while revoked
- Hunting or fishing while on revocation/suspension
- Computer assisted remote hunting
- Take, purchase or sale of Threatened or Endangered Sp.
- Knowingly or willfully introducing an aquatic invasive sp.

Criminal Revocation Categories and Points

- All 20 pt. violations would remain the same except those upgraded to 40 pt. egregious violations
- 17 pt. Hunting in wrong GMU, outside ranch boundaries with RO license or on public with a private land only license would increase back to 20 pts.
- The vast majority of 15 pt. violations would be reduced to 10 pts except exceeding the bag limit of BG and importation/possession of class II, III or IV species

Administrative clean up

- Make suspension process more efficient
 - Send notice via letter of PA, PRA, IWVC, failure to appear and failure to pay civil suspensions
 - If there is a mistake, they have come into compliance or been reinstated in their home state the Department will unsuspend the individual
 - Give individuals additional time if timeline falls on a holiday or weekend
 - Make commission rule more consistent with other administrative rules in NM to include MVD
