# Javelina Biology & Background Information


- Concentrated in southern part of NM
- Yearlong breeding season
- Up to 2 litters in 1 year
- High reproductive potential
- Hunting likely does not impact populations






#### **Harvest Data**

 Avg. 3.8 days hunted (stable)





- Increased success through time (license sales ↑ since 2017)

#### Proposed changes

- Add population management hunt option
- Expand WMAs where javelina can be hunted: River Ranch, Double E, Red Rock
- Remove ability to hunt javelina during deer/elk hunt
- Increase bootheel licenses by 10% and statewide licenses by 20%.
- Increases in length of season and standardize season dates
  - 1/1-1/31: archery
  - 2/1-3/31: rifle (youth & adult hunts)



### **Public involvement**

- Hosted 2 public meetings (virtual)
  - 118 signed up, 59 attended
- Received 23 email comments
  - Support for proposals (7)
  - Removing ability to hunt during deer/elk
    - For (3), Against (3)
  - Price of license too high (3)
  - Should have to remove meat from field (5)
    - Against lengthening rifle season (2)
