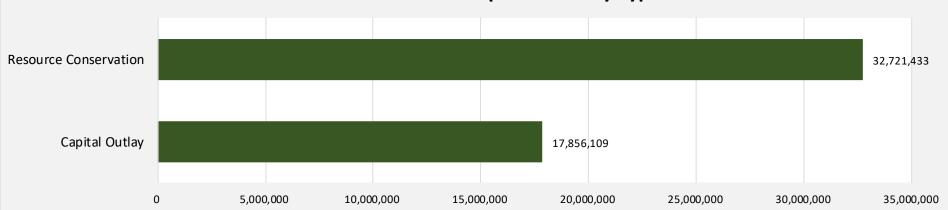

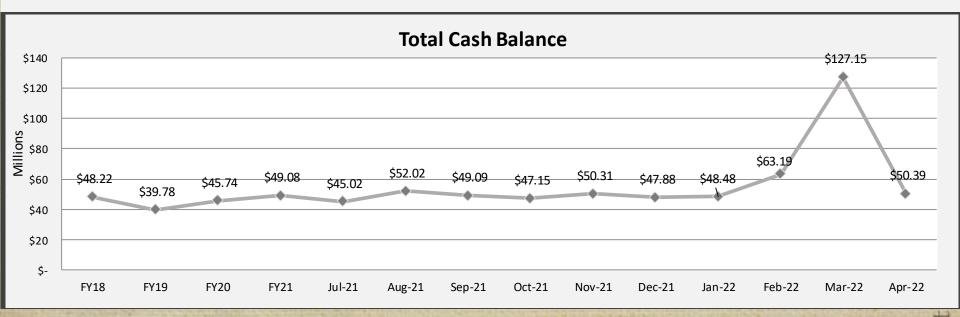
### Fiscal Year-to-Date Expenditures by Type

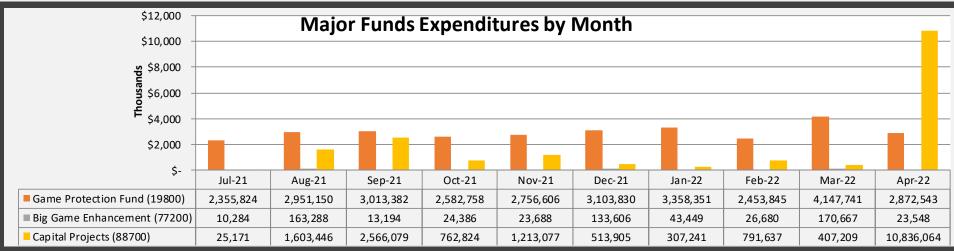


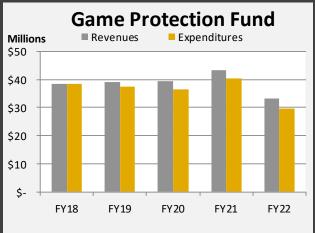


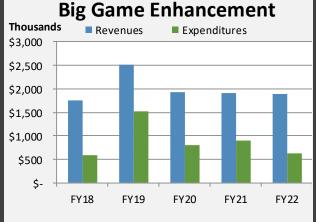


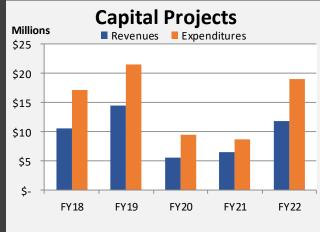


#### **MAJOR FUND EXPENDITURES**



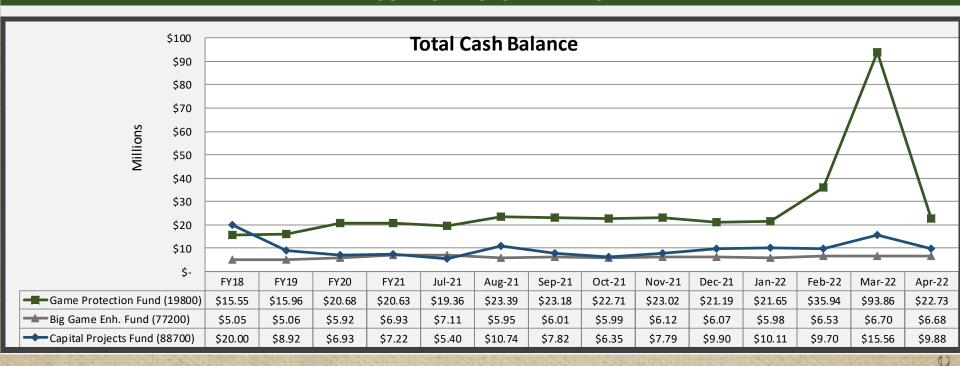

# GPF-5 Year Cash Projections

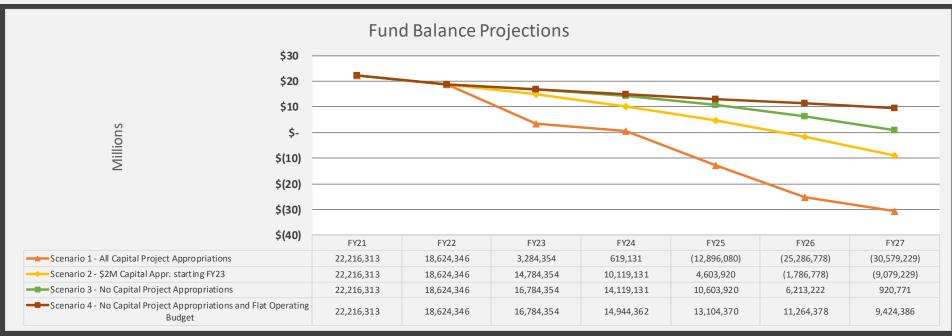
