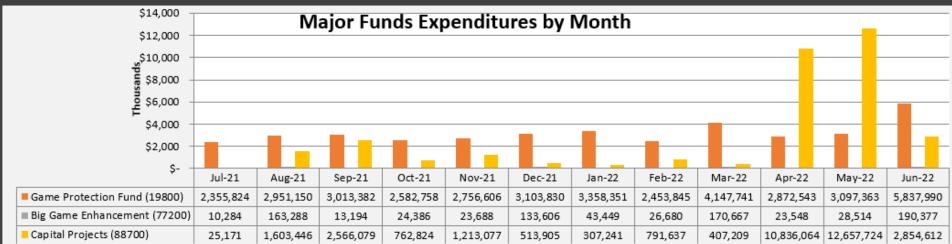


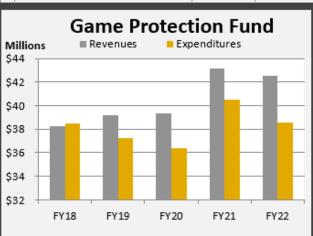


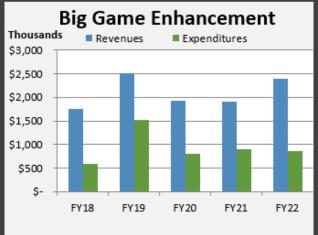


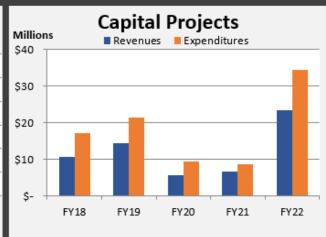


MAJOR FUND EXPENDITURES











MAJOR FUND CASH BALANCE





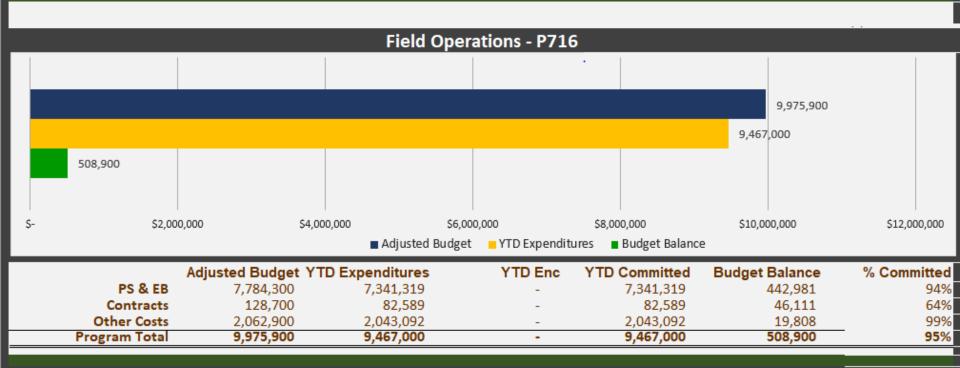

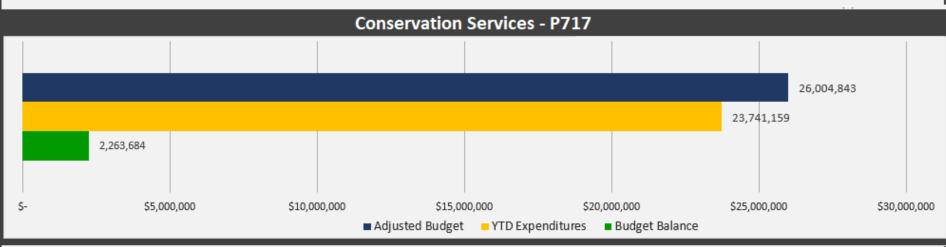
CC Actual vs. Budgeted Operating Expenditures by Program

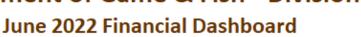

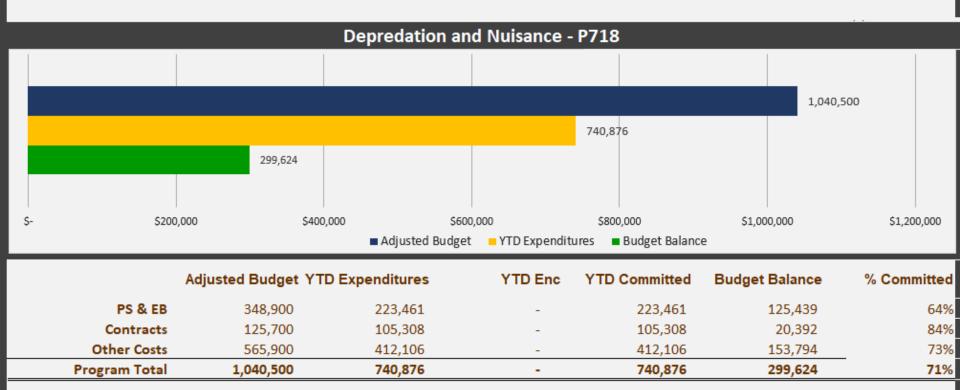

CC Actual vs. Budgeted Operating Expenditures by Program







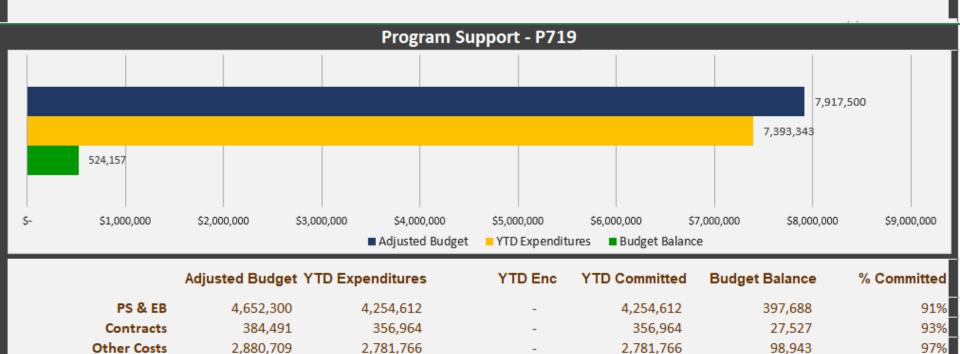

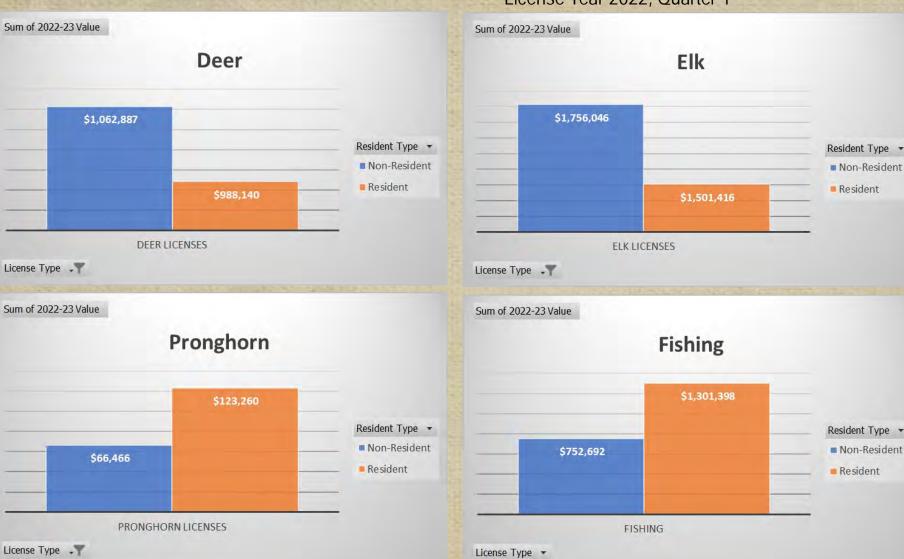


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License Sales Revenue

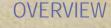

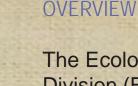

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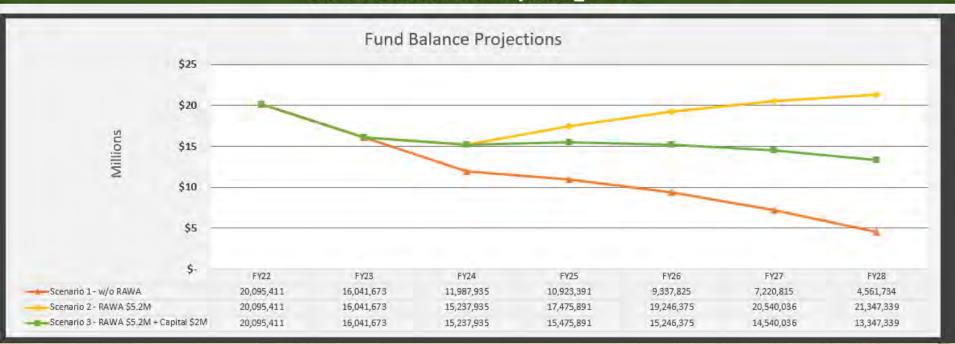
