




North Spring is one of three unique springs that occur outside of Hatch, NM.

These springs are an oasis in the desert and offer a refuge for wildlife in Southern New Mexico. North Spring is the largest of the three in the complex.

Currently, there is a four strand wire fence around the spring to protect it from cattle. However, the fence frequently fails and requires a great deal of maintenance.

The Department, along with the Las Cruces office of the BLM, would like to convert this fence to a pipe fence to reduce maintenance, especially during monsoon season.








Background Information

- The Las Cruces BLM manages a complex of springs outside of Hatch, NM.

 North Spring is the largest of the three springs. There is currently a 75 acre 4 strand wire exclosure fence around the spring.
- The current fence needs consistent maintenance, especially during monsoon season.
- The Department and the BLM would like to convert the 4 strand wire fence into a pipe fence. A pipe fence will require little to no maintenance and allow the habitat to regrow and remain intact for wildlife.
