The mission of the Share with Wildlife program at New Mexico Department of Game and Fish (NMDGF) is to help those species that do not receive funding from any other source. The program funds wildlife-focused **research, education, habitat enhancement, and rehabilitation** activities all around New Mexico.

A HMAV will get you access to New Mexico State Game Commission owned or controlled lands to enjoy an abundance of outdoor recreation and wildlife-viewing opportunities. These lands include Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) and are managed by NMDGF for the benefit of fish, wildlife, and their habitats (see more details [here](#)). Your HMAV fee will go towards future habitat enhancement activities on these properties.

Annually, the Share with Wildlife program funds an average of 10 projects and distributes around \$200,000 dollars, all in support of New Mexico’s wildlife. Share with Wildlife depends on **tax-deductible** donations from the public. ALL donations support wildlife projects, NOT program administration.

Projects funded through Share with Wildlife include distribution, status, and population **surveys** of species of conservation concern; **educational programs** that give K-12 students experience collecting and analyzing scientific data in the field; and **wildlife rehabilitation facilities** that care for and heal sick and injured wildlife.
