HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- There are 7 monthly challenges. Compete in one, two or all seven to complete the series.
- Find the details for each monthly challenge on the on the NMDGF website. Click here for easy access: http://www.wildlife.state.nm.us/education/archery/virtual-challenge Each virtual challenge can be conducted at school or at home.
- State & local social distancing guideline regarding Covid-19 must be followed.
- A large, safe & open environment with a suitable backstop to contain stray arrows must be utilized.
- Strict adherence to the archery safety guidelines listed above must be followed.
- Each virtual challenge must be conducted under the direct supervision of an adult.

CHALLENGE SCHEDULE & FORMAT

- Seven (7) scheduled monthly challenges (January through July).
- Monthly printable target faces will be available on the NMDGF website.
- Print the monthly target face on 8.5" x 11" paper & tape it to your own target.
- Scores will be the result of 15 arrows (5 ends of 3 arrows).
- Shooting distance to target: $6-8 \text{ yds } (1^{\text{st}} 5^{\text{th}} / \text{Elem}), 8-10 \text{ yds } (6^{\text{th}} 8^{\text{th}} / \text{Mid}) \& 10-12 \text{ yds } (9^{\text{th}} 12^{\text{th}} / \text{HS}).$
- Choose your bow style: NASP Genesis bow; Compound w/sight; Traditional-no sight; Olympic Recurve.

REPORTING SCORES

- Submit your scores as many times as you wish until each challenge closes.
- Your best submission will be your final score for that monthly challenge.
- Only scores submitted by each challenge deadline will be considered for the end of series coin.
