



PACE: Lobo Gris Mexicano

- General coordination at Trilateral Committee (US-Mexico-Canada) meetings since mid-1980s
- Recovery planning in 2003-2005
- Discussion of current reintroduction intent at May 2009 Trilateral Committee meeting
- Coordination/planning meeting with USFWS, AGFD, and NMDGF on July 7, 2009





- During 2007-08 six areas were selected and studied in terms of availability of prey and social perception about wolf reintroduction:
 - 4 in Western Sierra Madre (Chihuahua, Sonora, Durango, Zacatecas)
 - 2 in East Sierra Madre (Coahuila, Nuevo León, Tamaulipas)



- Two areas were selected for potential reintroduction:
 - Chihuahua Sonora (the first area to release wolf packs)
 - Chihuahua Centro

The Sonora-Chihuahua region was selected as the first area for Mexican wolf reintroduction in Mexico
