Recommendation Regarding the Jemez Elk Herd (GMU 6A/6C)



Management Options

- WMD Recommendation No change to boundary Emphasize increased quality and quantity of elk in 6C
 - GMU 6A: no change to private and public allocation
 - GMU 6C: Department plan to improve herd quality

2. Combine 6A and 6C – Maintain quality in old 6A

- Private and public allocation would decrease
- Boundaries would combine allowing hunters a larger area to hunt

3. Change 6A/6C boundary

- Various boundary options
- Most redistribute public and private hunting opportunities to take advantage of 6A herd quality in current 6C
