


# Actions Taken Towards Delisting Desert Bighorn Sheep, as Required by the WCA

### Recovery Criteria

Threatened: ≥ 250 bighorn in at least 2 populations or metapopulations, each containing ≥100 bighorn.

 Delisted: ≥ 500 bighorn in at least 3 populations or metapopulations, each containing ≥ 100 bighorn.



### Causes of Mortality

<ul> <li>Mountain lion predation</li> </ul>	76%
<ul> <li>Unknown</li> </ul>	13%
<ul> <li>Accidents</li> </ul>	4%
<ul> <li>Poaching</li> </ul>	3%
<ul> <li>Other predation</li> </ul>	2%
<ul> <li>Scientific collection</li> </ul>	1%

85% of Known-Caused Mortality was due to mountain lion predation

### Mortality Rates from Lion Predation Only

**Pre-Lion Control: 0.17** 

**Post-Lion Control: 0.05** 

\*71% decrease in lion-caused mortality\*


### Mortality Rates From All Causes of Mortality

**Pre-Lion Control: 0.23** 

**Post-Lion Control: 0.11** 


\*\*\*\*52% decrease in mortality\*\*\*\*

-Spring 2010 630


San Andres=128, Fras/Caballos=223, Bootheel=240
