- Commission opens Biennial Review
- Department accepts comments from public
- Department revises list of threatened and endangered species
- Commission opens 14 day comment period of proposed draft
- Department accepts comments on proposed draft list of threatened and endangered species and staff via hardcopy or email to leland.pierce@state.nm.us and revises list
- Commission reviews and accepts Director's recommendation



2012 Revised Draft

- No changes in status of any listed species
- Seven (7) changes in species scientific names
- Draft is available on Department website



Biennial Review Schedule

- September 10, open 14 day comment period
- September 23, close comment period
- November 1, present final Biennial Review to Commission for approval

 "Move to open the 14-day public comment period on the revised draft of the 2012 Biennial Review as presented to the Commission, and have the Director continue the Biennial Review process"
