
Pronghorn Antelope Hunt Structure Proposal

Objectives

- Simplify structure of pronghorn antelope hunting in NM
- Game Management Units 14, 18, 20, 29-34 & 36-40
- Public Draw licenses: Hunt legally accessible public lands, state trust lands and private land with permission
- Private Land hunting: Over the counter license with permission

Structure

- Combine GMU's with limited amounts of public land into one hunt code to allow for maximum access
- Spread out hunters over larger areas to reduce density issues
- Unitize areas within public land, state lease land and private land checkerboards
- Increase hunter opportunities where available
- Create "Quality" hunt zones to maintain trophy quality experiences
