

Species Amendments

- Possession limits have increased from double to three times the bag limit for 2013-2014 season
- Cranes: decrease in bag limit to 2 birds



Species Amendments


Alternative Proposal: includes late season information from USFWS

- Multiple changes to bag/possession limits and scaup season;
- Decrease in sandhill cranes bag limit to 2 birds per season.

Bernardo and La Joya Waterfowl Management Areas


- Establish premium waterfowl hunts;

- Alleviate road degradation caused by flooding north of Hwy 60.




Bernardo Waterfowl Management Area
