## 17-3-7 G. (3) NMSA 1978 Authorizes the Director to Transfer a Hunting License to a Nonprofit Organization

- License must be donated by licensee.
- Appropriate license fees must be paid.



## Background

In January, 2014, the Commission amended their rule, 19.31.3.11 NMAC, to allow the approval of nonprofit organizations that promote youth hunting, fishing and trapping activities.



- The Donald R. Kemp Youth Hunting Club is a 501 (c)(3) nonprofit organization in Las Cruces
- Provides hunting and fishing instruction and opportunities to New Mexico Youth
- Currently most of their hunting is conducted out of state, due to available opportunities
- Would like to provide more hunts in New Mexico
