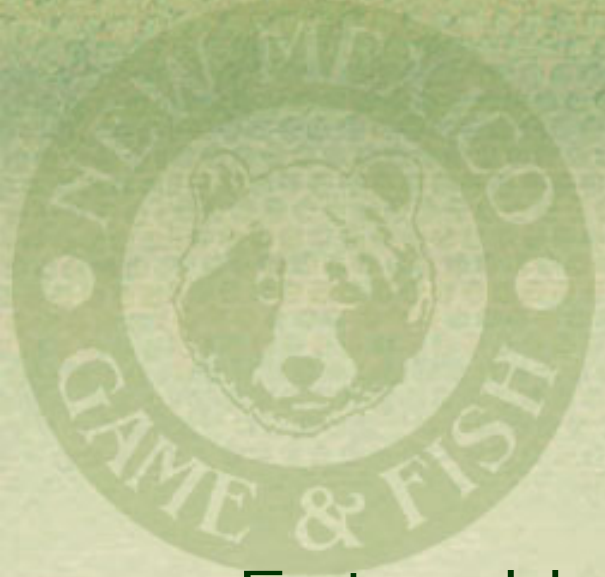
Public Comment

Final Amendments: Javelina 19.31.21 NMAC

- Adjust seasons for calendar dates
- Create a new non-military javelina hunt on McGregor Range of 5 licenses.



Final Amendments: Javelina 19.31.21 NMAC

- Extend bow hunts to entire month of January
- Extend the any-legal-weapon hunt occurring in GMU's 19,23,24,25,26,and 27 to a month long season; February 1 to March 1
- Define centerfire firearms and legal bullets
