

- Adjust season dates according to calendar and US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) frameworks
- Adjust bag/possession limits according to USFWS frameworks
- Final frameworks published in Federal Register in August

Proposed Amendments

- Sandhill crane allocation decrease from 248 last season to 217 for the upcoming season.
 Propose reduction in MRGV and SW hunt permits.
- Add authorization to cancel one or more hunts if the harvest is expected to exceed our federal allocation of greater sandhill cranes.


Proposed Amendments

- Adjust dove season in the south zone to allow for hunting on fall public school break.
- Adjust snipe season to allow for hunting after duck season ends.
- Add "ADJUSTMENT OF LICENSES, PERMITS, AUTHORIZATIONS, AND HARVEST LIMITS.
