Develop New Shooting Ranges

- Acquire Properties for Range Development
 - The Department has begun working with the Federal Land Management Agencies to Identify properties for shooting ranges.
 - Identified several locations statewide to acquire Land Patents through R&PP from the BLM.
 - Roswell
 - Santa Fe



Support Development of Existing Ranges Range Grants Programs

- Purpose to assist external non-profit shooting facilities.
 - 46 Shooting Ranges Statewide
 - Military, For-Profit & Not for Profit
 - 33 Ranges could be eligible for assistance



Range Grants Programs

- Matching Grants Program
 - Funding from Federal Aid Pittman Robertson Wildlife Restoration Grant
 - Use In-Kind, Materials or Dollars
 - Grants provide
 - Construction (Berms, Shades, Pads, etc.)
 - Safety Upgrades
 - Facilities (Bathrooms, Classrooms, etc.)

Club Structure

- Use a Youth Development Model
 - Same as Hunter Education, NASP, 4-H etc.
- Lead Instructor or Coach
 - Must be 21 years or older
 - Meet all NMDGF Volunteer Requirements
 - Background Check, etc.
 - Have a Certified National or State Accreditation training to teach youth and shooting sports.
 - 4-H Shooting Sports Certification
 - NRA Certification
 - National Sporting Clays or Skeet Certification



Club Structure

- Participate in one or more of Shooting Sports Disciplines
 - Hunting Skills
 - Rifle
 - Archery
 - Shotgun
 - Muzzleloading
 - Pistol

Club Funding

- Based on available funds and club enrollment
 - Provide grants
 - Consumables
 - Supplies
 - Safety Equipment
 - Support will be allocated annually



Club Funding

Establish a Club Kit Loaner Program

- To be checked out to a club or team to conduct a program
- Kits available should include
 - 2 rimfire rifles, 2 muzzleloaders, 2 shotguns, 3 bows, Field guides and handbooks, compasses, optics (2 binoculars, 1 spotting scope, 1 range finder), posters and safety information.
