#### Migratory Game Bird 19.31.6 NMAC

ADJUST according to calendar and US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) frameworks.

ADD: "ADJUSTMENT OF LICENSES, PERMITS, AUTHORIZATIONS, AND HARVEST LIMITS: Director's authority, with the verbal concurrence of the chairman or his designee, to adjust the number of licenses, permits, authorizations, or harvest limits, up or down by no more than 20%.

#### Sandhill Crane

#### Allowable harvest

- 3-year average of crane survey counts, recruitment, brood size
- calculation set by the cooperative Flyway (Central and Pacific) management plan
- Survey indices down for the 4 of the last 6 years.
- 2013 fall recruitment was 20% below the long-term average

#### Sandhill Crane

Greater sandhill crane allocation decrease from 248 last season to 217 for the 2014-2015 season.

Propose a reduction in permits for 3 hunts.




# Bernardo youth hunt change

# Bernardo WMA planned new youth hunt area







- Central Flyway believes more rigorous data is needed.
- Service Regulations Committee requested that the two Flyways develop harvest strategy.
- Meeting in CO in October to begin discussions.
