



State Wildlife Areas

Chama River Fishing Easement





Smoke from the coal-fired Cumbres and Toltec narrow gauge quite often drifts down over the Chama River, flooding the valley with a smell from long ago.

The Chama River Fishing Easement, consisting of two tracts of land, is located west of US 84 about two miles below downtown Chama. This popular fishing area annually produces limits of rainbows. In the fall months, browns seem to be the quarry of the Chama angler.
