



State Wildlife Areas

Tres Piedras Wildlife Area





Purchased in 1940 to provide a restoration area for sage grouse and antelope, the 3,260-acre Tres Piedras Wildlife Area typifies the high prairie lying along the deep gash of the Rio Grande Gorge, which has cut its way through time and rock just a few miles east of here.

It was covered by sagebrush at the time of the purchase, and some 2,300 acres of the Tres Piedras area were plowed or chained off to be reseeded with wheatgrasses and legumes.
