NEW MEXICO STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

SATURDAY, MARCH 11, 2023

## Tournament Rules and Information:

1. Go to [www.nasptournaments.org](http://www.nasptournaments.org) to register a team or individual.
2. Each archer will shoot 15 arrows at 10 meters and 15 arrows at 15 meters.
3. There will be no refunds for "no-shows." A shooting location will be reserved for each paid participant.
4. Only NASP students are eligible (students must be a participant of an in-school curriculum lasting 2-8 weeks, a minimum of 10 hours).
5. Only NASP students in grades 4th through 12th are eligible to compete.
6. Each archer may only shoot once for their tournament score.
7. Teams may consist of 12 – 24 archers which must include no fewer than four of each gender. Only one team per school is allowed.
8. If school doesn't meet the minimum requirements for a team, they may register archers in the individual category.
9. Schools can register an additional 12 archers listed as "individual" archers beyond their designated team of 12 – 24.
10. Competitions will consist of teams from three divisions: Elementary (Grades 4 – 5); Middle (Grades 6 – 8); and High School (Grades 9 – 12).
11. Coaches must be NASP Basic Archery Instructor (BAI) certified with "active" credentials to register students.
12. Teams with qualifying scores will be eligible to attend the Western National Tournament. Team scores equal the sum of the top 12 archers, which must include no fewer than four of each gender.
13. First-place team in each division qualifies for the Western National Tournament, regardless of team score.
14. Tournament fees must be paid in full prior to March 11, 2023 to NASP Inc., c/o Michelle Huibregtse to be eligible for awards.
15. All Registration documents must be signed and submitted to Bruce Atencio, NASP State Coordinator at [Bruce.Atencio@dof.nm.gov](mailto:Bruce.Atencio@dof.nm.gov).
16. Event Coordinators' decisions are considered final.

## Registration

### TIER ONE: 24 Archers (no more)

**OPENS FEB. 7, 2023, 12 A.M. MST**

\*Register up to 24 archers per division: Elementary, Middle School, High School

### TIER TWO: Expansion Tier

**OPENS FEB. 9, 2023, 12 A.M. MST**

(Open to accommodate additional individual archers beyond the Tier One limit of 24)

\*register a maximum of 12 additional archers per division

## Registration fee

\$12 per archer (includes an official NASP State Tournament T-Shirt for all archers registered by February 14)

## Drop by Date

Feb. 26, 2023 (school will be responsible for payment for all rostered archers after Feb. 26)

## Registration limits per school

► **Tier one:** Opens Feb. 7, 12 a.m. MST. Schools will be allowed to register UP TO 24 archers per division with a maximum roster of 24.

► A school that has more than one division (i.e. elementary, middle school, high school) will be allowed to register UP TO 24 archers PER DIVISION with a maximum roster of 24 per division.

► Schools without enough archers to make a team (12-24) should still register during Tier One Registration. (Every school has the opportunity to register UP TO 24 archers in Tier One.)

► **Tier Two:** Opens Feb. 9, 12 a.m. MST. Schools will be allowed to register a max roster of 12 individual archers (pending available flight position openings).

## Awards

**TEAM TROPHIES:** 1st, 2nd and 3rd place by division

**INDIVIDUAL MEDALS:** Top 10 males and females per division

**CHAMPION PRIZE BOW:** Top individual male and female archer per division.
